§ 1 Due dates

- 1. For a given year, the fee is due on January 1.
- 2. The fee for the ongoing year in which a member joins is due at the beginning of the next month.

§ 2 Regular fees and due dates

- 1. Ordinary members.
 - 1. Ordinary members pay a yearly fee of 24 EUR.
 - 2. Students, apprentices and retirees pay a reduced fee of 12 EUR.
 - 3. The board can reduce the fee of individual active members to an appropriate amount upon request.
 - 4. The board may request proof of eligibility for a reduced fee.
- 2. Supporting members pay a yearly fee of 120 EUR.
- 3. Honorary members pay no fees.
- 4. The fee for the ongoing year in which a member joins is the yearly fee divided by twelve, times the remaining amount of full months in that year.
- 5. Any member can voluntarily pay an increased fee. They can declare any fee above their minimum fee to apply from the next due date on towards the board.

§ 3 Delayed payments

- 1. Members whose payment is delayed or fails are asked by the board via email to, within two months starting at the due date, pay their fees or agree on a reduced fee per § 2.
- 2. Members may be charged for costs incurring from failed payments.

§ 4 Means of payment

Membership fees can be paid with one of the following options:

- SEPA direct debit
- Wire transfer
- Credit card
- Cash
